



Overview

As with all our tours there is always a friendly tournament included. You don't have to be a great golfer to take part, we have a daily competition and there will be prizes for the overall winners.

The Courses

The internationally designed courses are amongst the best in Asia, you will play Black Mountain, Banyan Golf Resort, Royal Springfield, Nikanti, Alpine, Booyoung Country Club, Phokeethra & Angkor Resort.

The tour kicks off on the 26th March in Siem Reap, Cambodia and is limited to 36 golfers.

Everyone will arrive in Siem Reap on different flights during the day and check into the 5-star Sokha Angkor Resort Hotel, the event starts with the welcome cocktail function that evening then its straight into the golf next morning.

There are many destinations around the world where you can stay at a nice hotel and play golf for a week on good courses. However; there are very few **exotic destinations** that offer “**world class golf courses**” designed by the best in the business, **luxury 5 star accommodation**, amazing food and all in an area bursting with culture and history.



The Tournament

The Cambodia leg of the event can be used as a warm up for the individual and team event which will start in Thailand. Although there will be a stableford daily event with prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. As with many of our tours there will be a betting pool with a USD\$10 entry fee per day. The tournament on the Thailand leg of the tour will be played over the first 3 rounds. It is a stableford event with daily and over all prizes. Everyone loved the 2018 event, no stress, competitive but lots of fun.

Golf professional Richard Ellis will be on tour playing with the group, so plenty of free tips for those in need of a swing fix or slight tune up.



After 4 nights in Siem Reap and 3 of the best courses Cambodia has to offer, the Best of Asia Tour continues with a short flight to Bangkok. After the transfer to Hua Hin we have reserved accommodation for the next 5 nights at the Hilton Resort and Spa.

The **Thailand Golf Classic** will take place on April 1st, 2nd and 3rd with the first round will be played at the Jack Nicklaus designed Royal Springfield, second round will be held at Banyan Golf Resort and the final round will be at Black Mountain. After 3 rounds of competition on 3 fantastic golf courses it's time to present prizes at the Grand Tournament dinner.

The next morning, we travel back to Bangkok and on the way stop for a round at one of Bangkok's best new courses, Nikanti Golf Club. After golf and dinner, we head toward Bangkok and the Westin Grande Hotel.

At all the courses in Thailand you will receive a sandwich and drink after 9 holes and at Nikanti a buffet dinner after golf. One more round at Alpine Country Club will round out the tour.

Caddies

International golf courses in Cambodia and Thailand, like most Asian countries provide caddies and carts for all players, this is included in your tour cost, however, please be aware that caddies are normally clothed, fed and sometimes housed by the golf course or resort. They usually only receive a small portion of the caddy fee charged by the course, so the only money they really make is from tips. We recommend that the notional tip you should give is in the order of USD\$10 to USD\$15 per round, they do a great job.

If you enjoy playing excellent golf courses, with your own personal caddy & cart, staying at top quality hotels, feast on some of the finest food in the world and off course a few beverages with your new golfing friends, you will love this experience.
