The rugged coastlines like you would see in Scotland and Ireland abound and the beaches make way for the dunes and to the farmland beyond. It is in this environment that Barnbougles has been crafted firstly with The Dunes course and more recently with Lost Farm and now the newly opened short course Bougles Run.

Barnbougles will challenge, delight and make you want to come back for more.

This is an opportunity to join us for a week on the North East coast of Tasmania, play in the inaugural Barnbougles Team Invitational and after the golf you may wish to extend your stay and visit some other sights that Tasmania has to offer.

From New Zealand & Australia there are a number of ways to fly to Launceston. The most efficient is usually direct, this is easily done with Virgin from Australia. Air NZ and Qantas can get there via Melbourne.

The Golf Courses.

Both the Dunes and Lost Farm play in and around the dunes of Anderson Bay and along the coastline of North East Tasmania. This could be one of the best golf destinations with two of the best courses you will have the opportunity to play in a short period of time. Within a week of opening in 2010 Lost Farm was rated in the top 10 courses in Australia, now it is rated #5 behind The Dunes at #4

The Dunes was designed by American Tom Doak and Australian Mike Clayton in the style of the traditional Links of Scotland and Ireland. Fairways are wide and the greens are lively, rolling with the natural undulations of the dunes. The 4th hole boasts the largest bunker in the southern hemisphere.



The Lost Farm is significantly different to its older brother. Designed with a minimalist approach by Coore Crenshaw, Lost Farm has 20 holes and the course layout meanders along the coast and between the dunes which are steeper than The Dunes course. Strategic bunkering and undulating greens are a feature and the golfer is helped out with wider fairways from which strategy is the key.



The Golf Courses – Bougle Run

Opened in 2021, Bougle Run was designed by acclaimed architect Bill Coore of Coore Crenshaw. There is 14 holes set atop the undulating sand dunes found behind the Lost Farm. The course consists of twelve par 3's and 2 par 4's and is set on the highest part of the property which allows spectacular 360-degree views of the course and Anderson Bay.



The Competition & Prizes

The tournament is a Team Best Ball Stableford competition, with daily and overall prizes. In the interest of fair play if you win an overall prize you will not be eligible for a daily prize. As with many of our tours there will be a daily betting pool for those who wish to partake \$10 entry per day- 1st 2nd & 3rd paid out (you don't have to enter this)

Over the week there will be individual competitions and the team's competition.

The individual competition will be a stableford event, with daily and overall prizes there will also be a 2 ball best ball team Stableford competition for players on the last day.

Team's event will be played as follows:

Each team will be made up of 4 players A, B, C, and D

Two of the team members will play together each day, (with two players from another team.)

The team members will rotate partners each day, so all team members will have a different playing partner each round.

Round one players A & B will play with 2 players from another team as will C & D

Round two players A & C, will play with 2 players from another team as will B & D

Round three players A & D will play with 2 players from another team as will B & C

The competition will be the pair's best ball stableford (best score on each hole from one player)

The team's score will be the total of both pair's best ball stableford scores each day.

Eg: Round 1 Players A & B = 44 points

 Players C & D = 46 points

Team Total round 1 would be 90 points. And so on for the 3 tournament rounds.

There will be a redraw and Calcutta / Auction for teams of 2 on the final days play at Bougle Run

Handicaps We will have a slope handicap chart available for round one of the tournament. After each round, players will be re-handicapped down or up depending on their day's score. Anyone playing within 2 strokes of their handicap, there will be no change for the next round.

Score three or four, better or worse than your handicap and your handicap for the next round will be plus or minus one stroke. Score five or more strokes "better or worse" will result in, minus or plus 2 strokes for their next round. The maximum handicap movement will be 2 strokes a day.

The Itinerary

This is the event program, however departure times and rotation of the golf courses could be subject to change

<i>Sunday 29th September</i>	Arrive Launceston and transfer to the Lost Farm where accommodation is reserved for the next 4 nights 6.00pm- 7.00pm Welcome drinks and BBQ
<i>Monday 30th September</i>	Buffett Breakfast 10.00am Depart the Lost Farm, transfer to the Dunes course for round one of the tournament.
<i>Tuesday 1st October</i>	Breakfast 10.00am Arrive downstairs, straight to the tee for round two of the tournament to be played at the Lost Farm course
<i>Wednesday 2nd October</i>	Breakfast 10.00am Arrive downstairs, straight to the tee for the final round of the tournament to be played at the Lost Farm course 4.00pm Presentation to winners and Calcutta to be held in The Sport Bar
<i>Thursday 3rd October</i>	Breakfast 8.30am Early tee time for Bougle Run, 2 Ball Best Ball.
<i>Thursday 3rd October</i>	12.00 Midday Transfers to Launceston Airport for your homeward journey.
